The required material (code and documentation, viewable on the network) should be handed in **no later than Tuesday 6/12** at **10.00**. It is very important to keep this deadline!

P6: Sales-oriented final presentation of your results, with the other groups as potential knowledgeable and demanding customers. Testing/demo according to web page.

Any required adjustments (remaining after P6) of the software or the documentation should be provided no later than **one week after feedback received or at an agreed upon deadline with your supervisor**.

Bold items F9, P1, P2, P5 and P6 are compulsory. Occasionally, e.g. in case of sickness or travels, agree with your group and inform your teacher. Time, place, and form (computer room, e-mail, etc.) for the sessions P3 and P4 depends on each group (advancement or type of problems) and on teacher preferences.
