## 1 Background

Students at LTH have for a long time sought an easy way to sell unwanted literature to fellow students. As courses come and go the flow of books from person to person needs to be facilitated. Currently this is done through notes on noticeboards around the campus. This is an outdated procedure and the need for an electronic system exists.

## 2 Goals

An easy and quick web service for students at LTH to buy and sell books to each other. The solution should eliminate any need to ever put up a notice on a noticeboard ever again.

## 3 Functionality

- create a profile on the webpage.
- log in and log out.
- buy and sell books.
- look up information about a book.
- set a condition, price and write a description for your copy of the book.
- search for books (title, course, edition, ISBN, tags etc.)
- sellers should be able to tag a book with for example the course it is used in, studying year and program, speciality and so forth.
- possibility to report users that abuse the system to an administrator.
- connect the student's university account to the profile. Data from course registration in the LU-account should be used to present likely books the user will need.
- tag unofficial course literature as recommended substitute literature for the course.
- write and read book reviews.
- the seller should be able to choose the buyer who gets to buy the book.
- the seller and buyer should be able to communicate after the seller has accepted the buyer and also rate each other.
- see ratings of other users.
