Jonas Gabrielsson will as his point of departure use his experiences with teaching entrepreneurship courses at The Lund University School of Economics and Management (LUSEM). His main focus will be on intrapreneurship, i.e., entrepreneurship in established companies. He will give an overview of the status of the field today, and also present his ideas of how to organize intrapreneurship teaching for business students. Finally, he will share his reflections about teaching classes with a fair amount of foreign exchange students.

For the last four years, Jonas Gabrielsson, PhD, has been Associate Professor at CIRCLE, Centre for Innovation, Research and Competence in the Learning Economy. For the time being Jonas is doing research regarding "The Entrepreneurial University and Research Based Ventures" and he teaches among others the course "Corporate entrepreneurship and growth".
