
To achieve a combination of **transport** and **warehousing** dressed and penetrated by a well-run **system**.




- ✓ Sea Cargo Logistics

- Less influence weather circumstances











The story of H.Essers Danmark



History of H.Essers Danmark ApS

- Founded first of July 2008
- Reason: One of our main customers in Belgium wanted to outscource their Denmark activities
 - Current in Belgium ca. 50.000 pallets storage
- Customer handled own production and warehousing facilities of chemicals in the center of the city (Valby).



History of H.Essers Danmark ApS

- Decision process to start-up business in Denmark:
- Customer request in first place
- Due to long term strategic partnership our principle is that we follow our customer where ever they go.
- Ecolab took the decision earlier to settle in Copenhagen
- An involved take over of personnel limited the new location possibitlies to a close range of Copenhagen.
- Interesting opportunity as a gate to Scandinavia



H.Essers Danmark ApS - Project

- Project description:
- 8.000 to 10.000 pallets
- Distribution center for all Nordic countries (Denmark, Sweden, Norway Finland and Russia)
- First stage: only warehousing services
- Cleaning products Dangerous goods
- Cleaning equipment Non dangerous goods



H.Essers Danmark ApS – Project

- Project history:
- 01/05/2008: Initial question from customer to explore possibilities
- 21/05/2008: Signed Letter Of Intent (LOI)
- 01/06/2008: Foundation of H.Essers Danmark ApS
- 23/06/2008: Lease agreement on building
- 29/09/2008: Start operational activities "equipment"
- 21/10/2008: Start operational activities "compound"
- In 6 months from zero to a full operational warehouse



- Very tight timeline
- Transfer of undertakings take over of employees
- Cultural differences (between countries, between companies)
- No experience in Denmark
- Local laws, regulations, environmental issues and their complexity
- No own build warehouse and no preferred set-up



- Very tight timeline
- Entered the tender process in very late stage
- Orginal request in May, scheduled "go live" in August. Nearly impossible...
- Limitation of possibilities
- Tight timeline as a red wire throughout the start-up



- <u>Transfer of undertakings take over of employees</u>
- Overtaking of the warehousing activities involved the overtaking of the employees as well
- No knowledge of Danish legislation
- Intensive involvement of lawyers (resulting in increased costs)



- <u>Cultural differences</u> (between countries, between companies)
- Underestimated factor
- Completely different working culture comparing Belgium with Denmark
- Completely different working culture between Flemmish family owned company and a Danish subsidairy of an American multinational.



- No experience in Denmark
- Start from scratch
- No connections available to rely on
- No supplier network
- Start-up assistance by Copenhagen Capacity



- Local laws, regulations, environmental issues and their complexity
- Storage of dangerous goods and their complexity
- Scepticism of local authorities because of the unknown
- Limited experience of local authority
- Long application processes
- Other mindset (business vs goverment)
- Very easy to establish a company



- No own build warehouse and no preferred set-up
- Difficulties in finding a warehousing location
- Some requirements concerning location, space, storage height, etc...
- Limited possibilities when taking above into account



H.Essers Danmark - Learning

H.Essers Danmark ApS – Learning

- Never under estimate cultural differences, even not in a country relatively close
- Adapt as soon as possible to the local culture. Integrate as a company.
- A start-up abroad takes time, a carefull planning is needed.
- Try to build up a network of partners and suppliers in advance. Their knowledge is critical for your success.
- Build up a relationship with local authorities. Trust is an important factor.



H.Essers Danmark - future

H.Essers Danmark ApS – Realisations

- Solid base of organisation buit up in Denmark
- Built up experience in foreign country
- Effiency gains through a continuous process of optimalizations (operational systems)

Number of operators Q4 2008:
 45 / 50 FTE (starting point)

• Number of operators 01/01/2009: 30 FTE (optimalization)

Number of operators 31/12/2009: 15 FTE (optimalization)

Number of operators 1/03/2010: 22 FTE (increase in activities)





H.Essers Danmark ApS – Future

- Organisation is set and original project has become daily routine
- The overall project was a great opportunity to enter the Danish/Scandinavian market.
- Next steps:
 - Different projects and extensions to current project with the customer are completed in this year. (Customer picking, EBS, Cruise)
 - Focus on other customers to fill the remaining 5.000 palletplaces
 - Further business development beyond current warehouse
