FASILIS: Stimulating new business development in Human Health

FASILIS (Facility Sharing in Life Sciences) is an international pilot project creating transnational links between SMEs and a European network of state-of-the-art facilities in six regions in The Netherlands, Belgium, England, Germany and Denmark. Part of the project is a voucher scheme. SMEs can apply for a voucher, worth €6.000,-, to buy an innovation service from a state-of the art facility in one of the participating FASILIS regions.

Call for vouchers opens march 10

On March 10, 2010 the call for vouchers will open. The vouchers offer SMEs working in the field of *Human health* the opportunity to buy an innovation service from a state-of the art facility in one of the participating FASILIS regions. Services include for example the use of laboratories and state-of-the-art equipment, prototyping or testing.

Through the network of Regional Contact Points (see the contact details below), the FASILIS team can offer personal support and advice in finding the right facility for your project. How to apply for a FASILIS voucher?

Finding a facility

SMEs interested in using a service of one of the facilities in the FASILIS network can contact their regional contact point to discuss innovation questions and to find a facility to match their needs. The FASILIS catalogue gives an overview of the

facilities currently in the FASILIS network. SMEs with a clear idea of what they need can directly check this catalogue. The network continuously grows so if you cannot find what you are looking for, just call your Regional Contact Point.



If the preferred facility is not in the database, but is located in one of the regions, please notify your Regional Contact Point. If the proposed facility is approved, it will be added to the online catalogue and will be eligible for cooperation in the voucher scheme.

Submitting a project proposal

To apply for a voucher, SMEs will have to fill in a **short** application form. This application form is part of the application pack available on the FASILIS website from March 10 onwards.

Applications for vouchers have to be submitted by sending a complete application in a single stage. Proposals must be sent by e-mail to the FASILIS lead partner (see website and application pack for details) by 17.00 PM Central European Time on the closing date of the call on Friday May 21, 2010.



In the Spotlight

In the spotlight showcases facilities and SMEs participating in FASILIS. Interested in connecting with a facility of company? Call your regional contact point. This newsflash we introduce NYtor a company in Nijmegen, the Netherlands.

Founded in 2007, NYtor is a contract research laboratory specialized in molecular diagnostics. NYtor works in close collaboration with HANbiocentre, a contract research and







education organization within the HAN University. This gives small scale companies direct access to the facilities and expertise of the university.

Besides HANbiocentre, NYtor collaborates with Bio-Rad, Biolegio and the Department of Molecular Genetics of the PHRI in Newark (USA).

NYtor specializes in tailor-made applications and solutions and offers its service to companies in the Netherlands. By joining the FASILIS network NYtor can promote their services to European companies. The network makes it easier to find new connections and increases the chance to be found by others. NYtor hopes that projects starting with a FASILIS voucher will be the beginning of long-term collaborations.

Even thought the call for vouchers starts on March 10, a connection has already been established between NYtor and a Belgium company called BioXpr. NYtor's expertise on molecular beacons will make BioXpr's in-silico design of Molecular Beacons more robust and reliable and therefore improving accuracy and specificity of qPCR (quantitative real time polymerase chain) reactions. The outcome of the collaboration is bound to be of high benefit to many users involved in the molecular diagnostics market.

The collaboration will work both ways: NYtor expects to be able to benefit from the improved qPCR software in future projects as well!

Busy second FASILIS matchmaking event in Copenhagen

Originally the number of attendees was limited to 60, David Featherston stretched it to 75 and in the end Morten Mølgaard Jensen of COBIS collected all chairs available in the building to seat 85 SMEs and other interested parties!

German SMEs in the STERN region are welcome to visit the matchmaking event in Stuttgart on March 24. Information about these events can be found at the FASILIS website.




