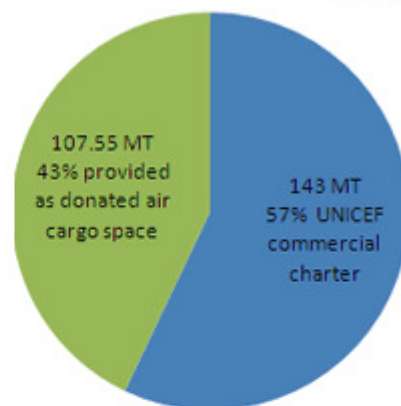


Haiti Earthquake - UNICEF Supply and Logistics Responses

Metric tonnes of UNICEF emergency supplies for Haiti relief between 16/01/01 - 22/01/10.

43% of space holding this cargo was donated by partners: British Airways, Thomas Cook, UPS, the Emirate of Dubai, and Air France/KLM.

Between 16 and 22 January, over 100 MT of UNICEF freight to Haiti (43% of the total) was donated by partners

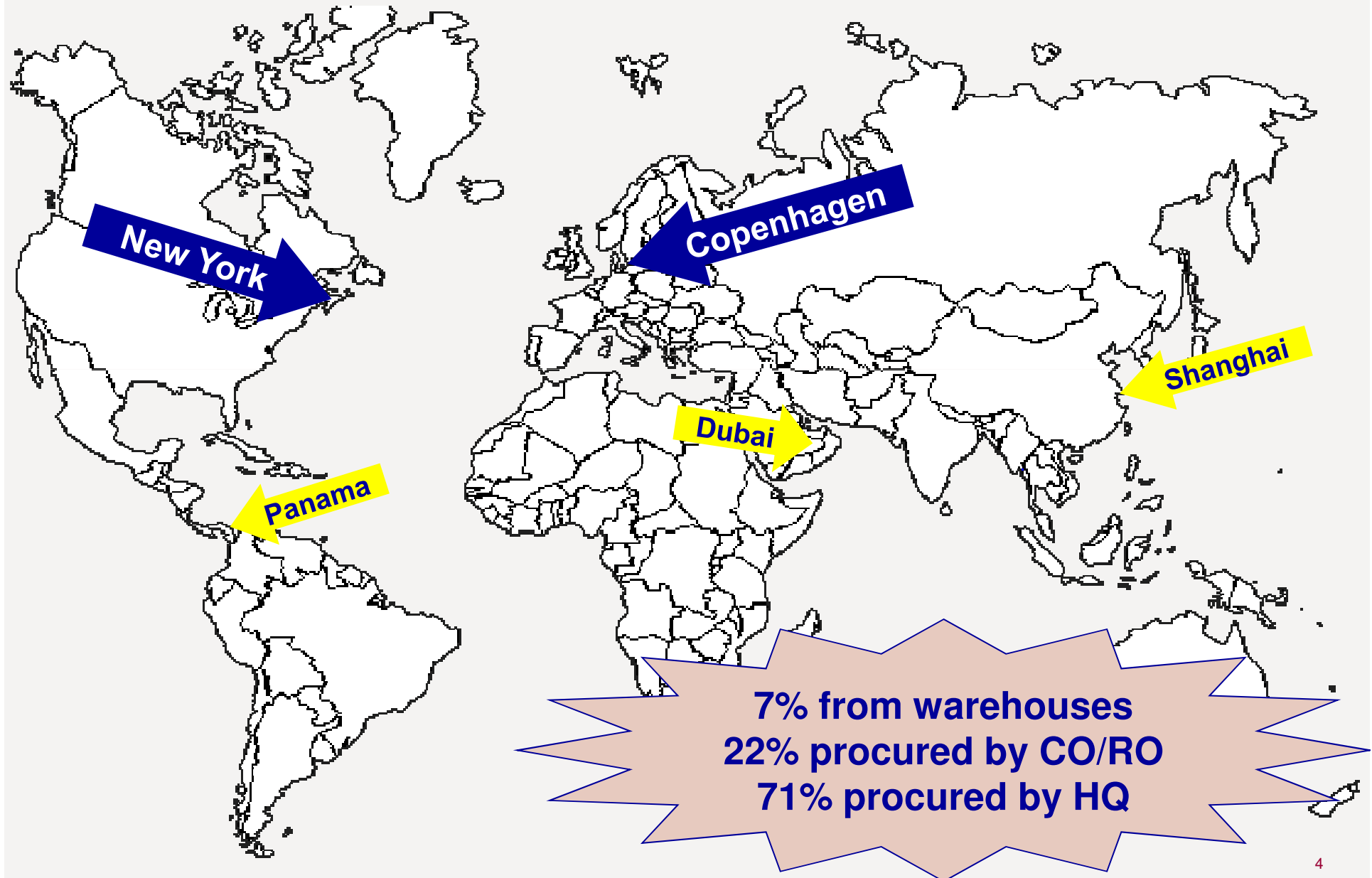

- UNICEF Core Commitments are: health and nutrition, education, water and sanitation, child protection and HIV/AIDS

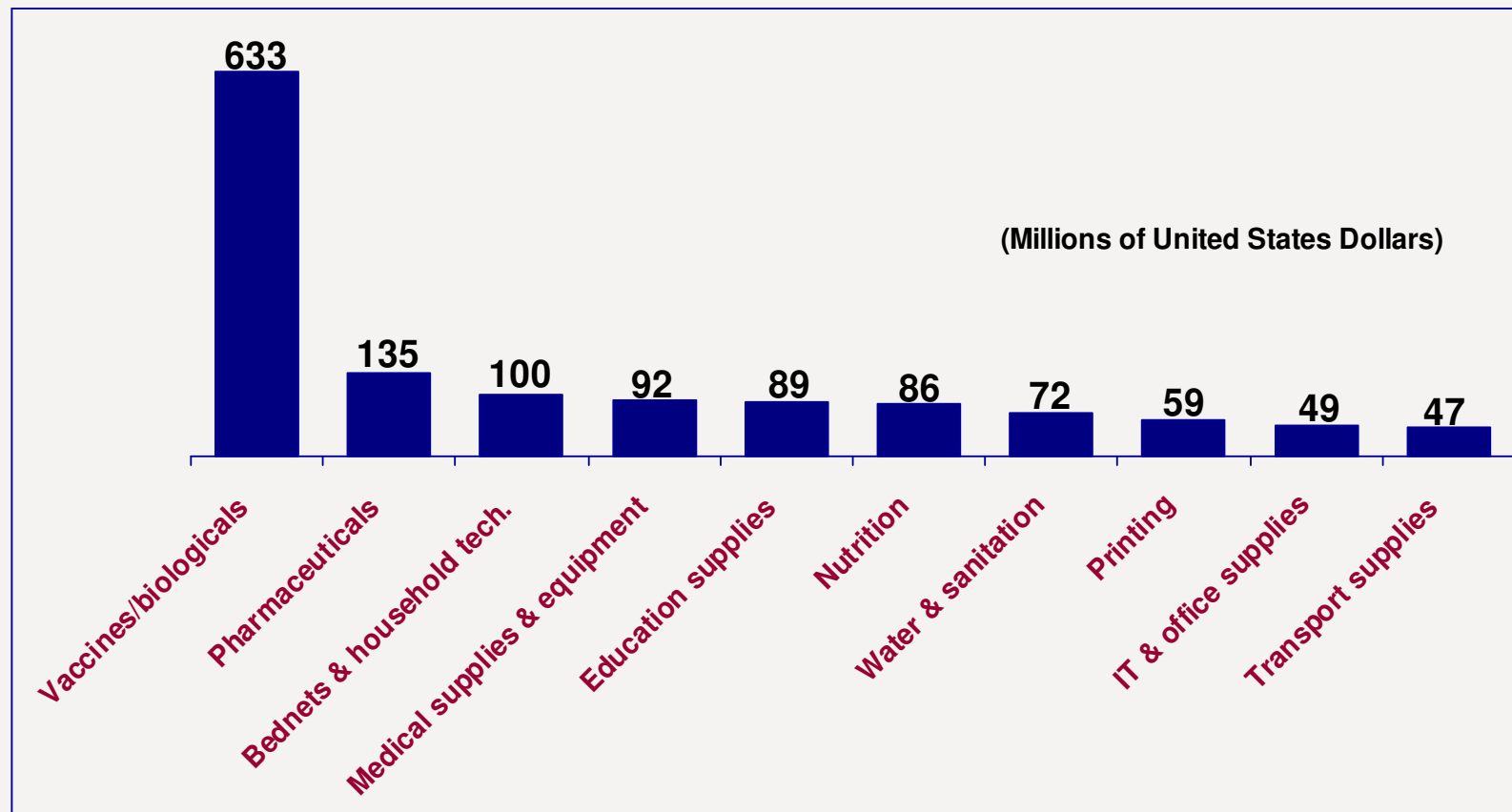


UNICEF PROCUREMENT IS GLOBAL AND LOCAL

WHAT DO WE BUY?



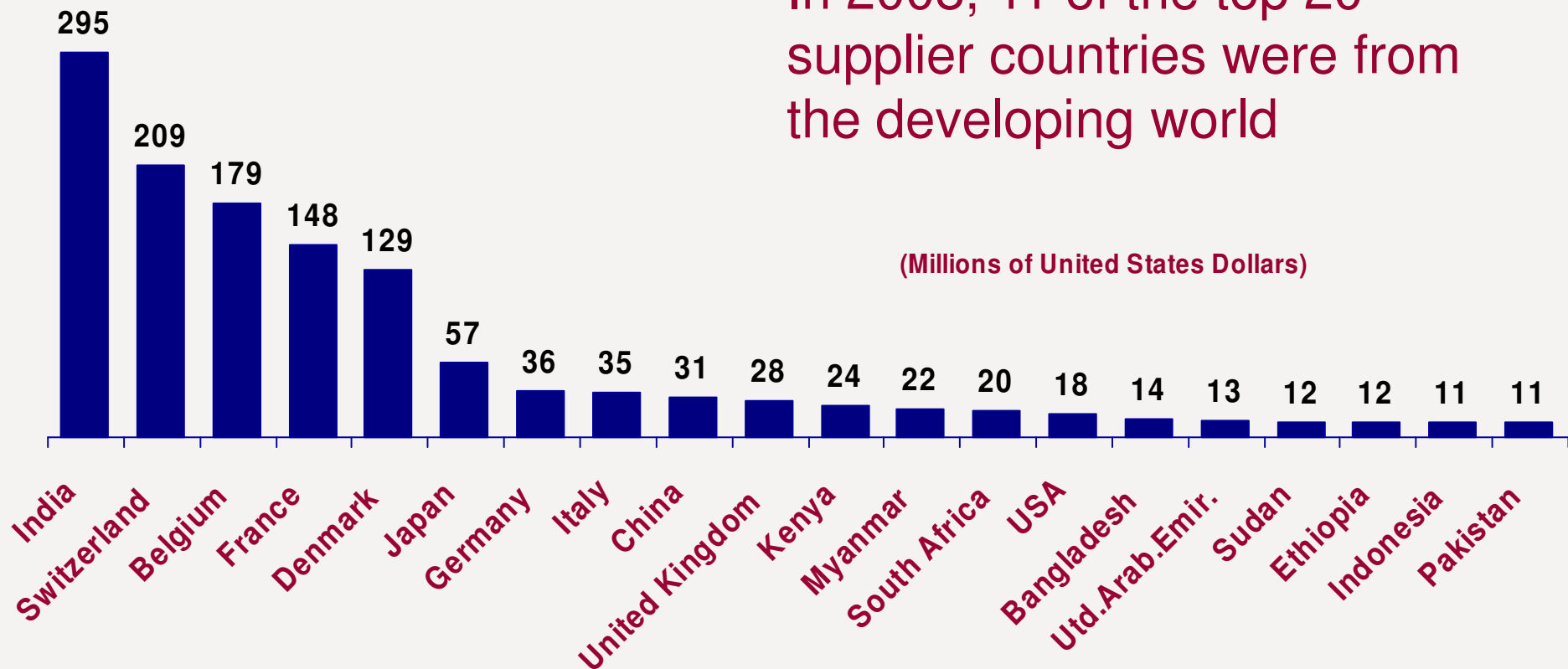
Total Procurement 2008: \$1.46 billion

UNICEF IS THE LEADING AGENCY FOR CHILDREN'S SUPPLIES

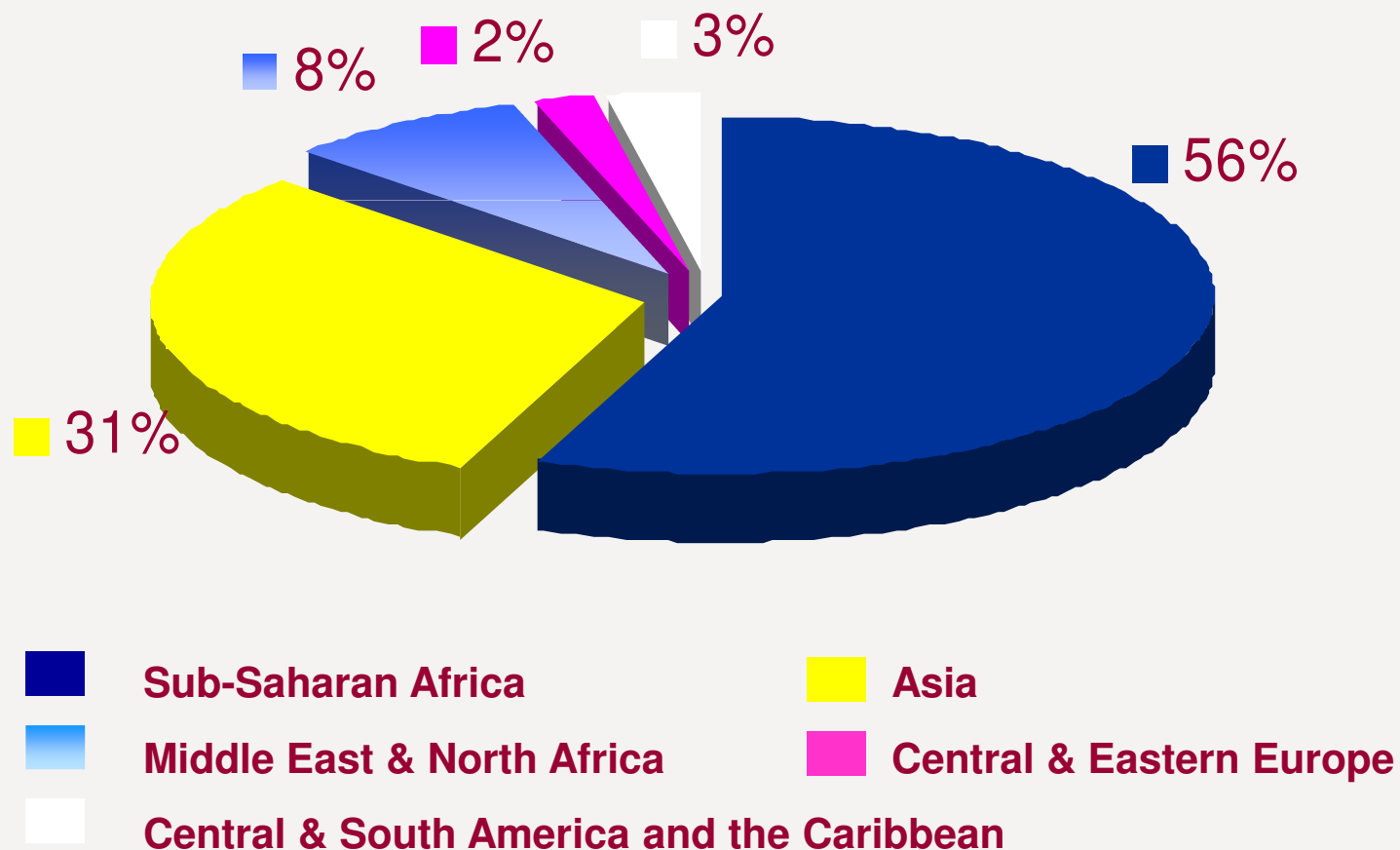
WHERE DO WE BUY?

Emergency preparedness

- Ready to send out standard supplies (including kits) within 48 hours
- Emergency supply list
- Copenhagen warehouse and emergency hubs: stockpile to cover the needs of a population of 250,000
- In 2008, Supply Division supported 74 countries in emergencies to a value of \$75.5 million

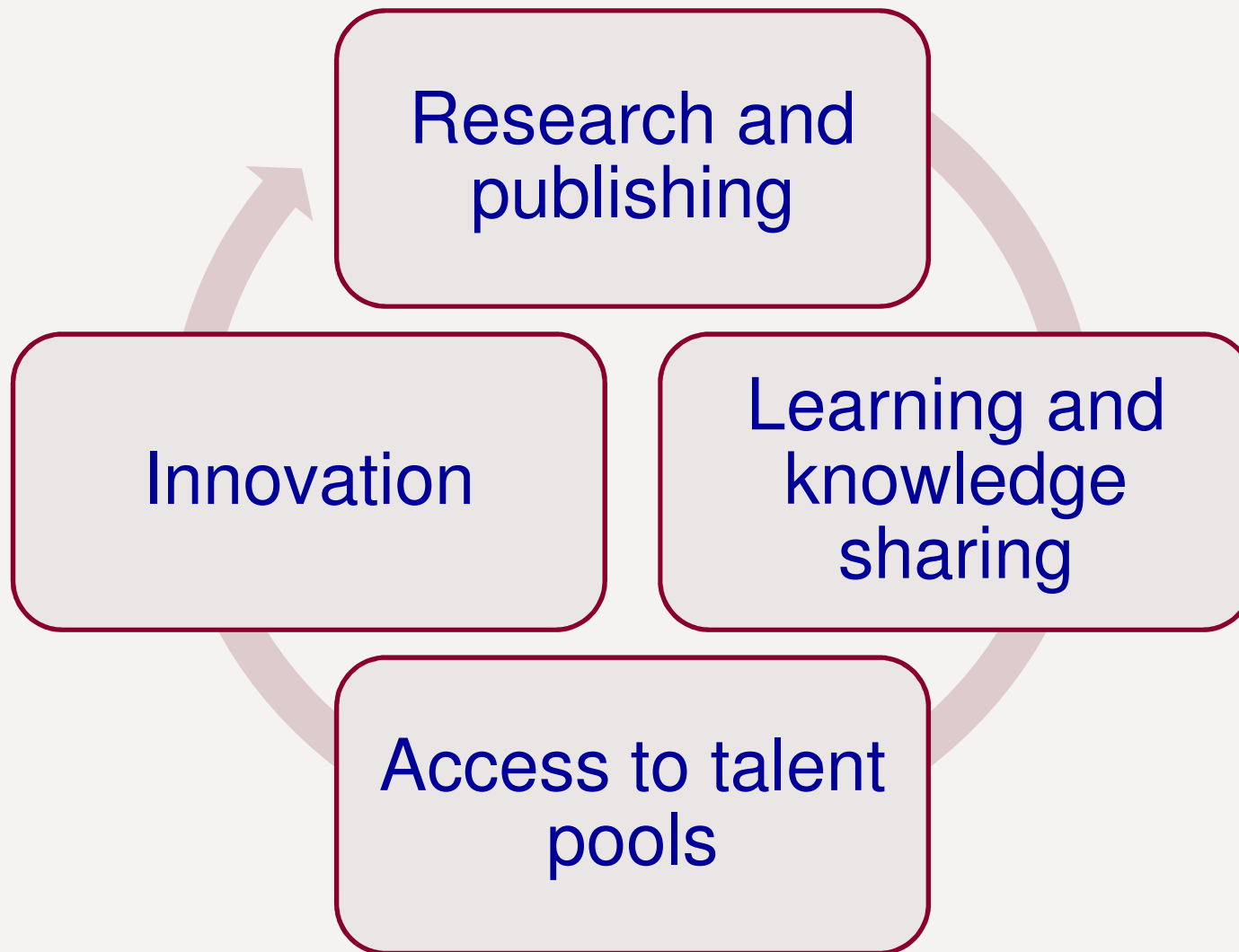
THE COPENHAGEN WAREHOUSE
