## **Instructions for experiment participants**

## Analytical Hierarchy Process

- 1. When you are ready to start, please write the start time.
- 2. Consider the stated question and circle the symbol that is most accurate for you: (<<< << << >> >> >>> >>>) for each comparison
- 3. When you have finished all comparisons, then note the stop time.
- 4. Now start with the second criterion and prioritise in a similar manner.
- 5. When you have finished all comparisons, then note the stop time.
- 6. Thank you!

## Planning Game

Perform the prioritisation for one criterion at a time.

- 1. When you are ready to start, please write down your name and the start time at the upper card of the criteria you should start with.

  (Green cards=Importance/Value and brown cards=Price)
- 2. Spread the cards out on the table in front of you.
- 3. If you start with the criterion *Importance/Value for me* then arrange the green cards into 3 groups in which the features are classified

(N)ecessary

(A)dds to the value

(U)nnecessary

4. If you start with the criterion *Added price on the phone* then arrange the brown cards into 3 groups in which the features are classified

(V)ery high price

(R)easonable price

(L)ow price /for free

- 5. Circle N, A or U and V, R or L on each card.
- 6. Now prioritise the features within each group for each criteria separately. This will give two piles of cards, one with features that are arranged in order of *Importance* and the other one in order of *Price*.
- 7. Mark each feature from 1 to 16 depending on its place in the pile, where 1 is least important/least expensive and 16 is most important/most expensive.
- 8. Write the stop time for each criterion.
